Broadway Sacramento offers the following services and accommodations to promote inclusivity and to make our shows accessible to all patrons.



Open captioning provides patrons Audio description provides patrons who are deaf or hard of hearing with a text display of the dialogue Patrons requesting this service will be seated in view of a screen displaying the captions in real time.



American Sign Language-interpreted performances are offered for patrons who are deaf or hard of hearing. Patrons requesting this service will be seated in view of an interpreter.



Hearing assistive devices are available for loan prior to each performance. A valid driver's license or other form of ID is required for deposit.



Tactile pre-show presentations offer patrons who are blind and visually impaired an opportunity for close-up, hands on interaction with the costumes and props from the show, accompanied by detailed descriptions from members of the production team.
